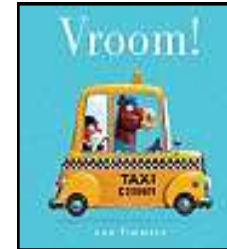

This Week's Early Literacy Skill: Letter Knowledge
